

Pabbay, Sound Of Harris Species List (October 2022)

Introduction

Pabbay dominates the western end of the Sound of Harris, midway between Harris and North Uist. Its long history of human occupation has shaped the landscape and ecosystems, and influenced its flora and fauna. Although it is currently only inhabited for part of the summer, the crofting activities still influence its landforms and biodiversity. (Harman 2022, Charlesworth & Buckland, Johnson 2022).

Almost two-thirds of the island's 820 ha is a Site of Special Scientific Interest. Designated in 1997, in recognition of the importance of its coastal geomorphology, machair and mires, bryophytes, wintering Greenland barnacle geese and breeding bird populations, it covers 552 ha of the southern part of island (NatureScot 2010).

The flora of the island has been particularly well documented, with records from naturalists visiting Pabbay in the middle of the last century: Charles Elton in 1935, J.W. Campbell in 1938 and W.A. Clark and J.W. Heslop Harrison 1940 and 1941 and more recently to T.C. Dargie in 1996 and R.J. Pankhurst and P.A. Smith in 2004. These records are available on the NBN Atlas Scotland website. In June 2022 a small group of recorders from Outer Hebrides Biological Recording (OHBR) visited the island and recorded the flora largely on the western part of the island and the freshwater alage in the lochs and marshy pools. The mosses and liverworts are also well document, but there were no records of freshwater algae prior to the limited survey in 2022. Similarly information on the fungi and liverworts is very limited.

Prior to 2022, the only information on the mammals and invertebrates is contained in the account of Charles Elton's visit to Pabbay in 1935 (Elton 1938).
